



Cancellation Policy

As an outdoor event Offshore Cinema is subject to prevailing weather conditions. Specifically, mild rain will not prohibit the screenings of films. Screenings will only be cancelled if weather conditions are deemed hazardous and puts the safety of patrons and staff at risk.

Patrons accept that in purchasing a ticket, they are paying for a screening that commences at approximately 8:40pm on the Frankston Foreshore, and that weather conditions prior to that time and in other parts of Melbourne will not result in a screening being cancelled. Patrons accept the risk that weather they consider unsatisfactory may occur on a screening night, and acknowledge that tickets will not be refunded. If the screening is cancelled due to hazardous weather tickets can be transferred to a screening of your choice.

In the unlikely event that a screening is cancelled, information will be posted on the event website, social media and ticket holders will be contacted directly to notify them of the cancellation.

Please note: due to changing weather conditions, cancellations may need to occur at short notice.

Patrons unwilling to accept this policy and the risk of inclement weather should plan to purchase tickets at the venue.
